The Senior Engagement Lead's key responsibilities are to:

- Design and lead Next25's participant pipeline and participant engagement strategy.
- Horizon scan for Australia-wide opportunities to engage new and existing stakeholders that support the success of Leadership and Transforming Parliament for Women.
- Develop and implement strategies for cultivating critical relationships that support the success of the two key initiatives.
- Work with the CEO, Board and Philanthropy Manager to nurture existing relationships.
- Formulate and implement government relations and advocacy strategy to secure, maintain and grow enrolments and build community for the initiatives.
- Develop and lead engagement events and activities beyond government (e.g. thought leadership or public engagement opportunities) that support these two initiatives.
- Assist with promoting the initiatives and creating communication collateral to target Federal, State and Territory parliamentarians and influencers in their ecosystem.
- Write and speak persuasively to diverse stakeholders.
- Contribute to grant applications and other fundraising activities to support these initiatives.
- Evolve, monitor, and report on program participation and engagement targets.
- Contribute to reporting and management of the engagement and programs administrative processes and tools (e.g. CRM / database)
